Telane was affectionately known to many as "Tina" or "The Boss Lady". The first signs of her tenacity came in her early youth as she learned to write using the flowered papered walls of the basement as a canvas. In her early education she was an excellent student and social butterfly. Tina graduated from Inkster High School in 1965 and went on to attend Ferris State University attaining a Bachelor's Degree as well as Eastern Michigan University earning a Master's Degree. In 1969 Tina married Larry Ransom, no children were from this union and Larry preceded her in death.

Tina began a lengthy and varied career employed by the City of Inkster in 1973 as an account clerk. From her hard work, attention to detail and dedication assisting with many other duties, she was promoted to the position of a Payroll Benefit Specialist. Tina's kindness, compassionate nature, and overall efficiency were a few of the great qualities she shared as a Personnel Specialist until her retirement in 2011.
